Chairman Minor called the August 16, 2021, Special Meeting of the La Paz County Board of Supervisors to order at 11:00 a.m. Elected Officials and Department Heads present were: Chairman Duce Minor, Vice-Chairman Holly Irwin, Supervisor David Plunkett, County Administrator Megan Spielman, Chief Deputy County Attorney Ryan Dooley, IT Tech Joey Lucas, Assessor Anna Camacho and Clerk of the Board Diane Green.

PUBLIC HEARING - Proposed Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Tax Levies for La Paz County taxing entities

County Administrator Spielman gave a presentation on the proposed tax levies for the county's taxing districts, thanking Assessor Camacho's staff and School Superintendent Waggoner for the "second set of eyes" in preparation of the presentation.

She went over the various schedules for the County, cities and towns, school districts, fire districts, fire district assistance tax payments and special districts.

Chairman Minor noted that the tax rates are ones submitted by the various taxing districts and are not created by the County.

County Administrator Spielman stated that the rates do follow a verification process to assure that their submissions follow what is allowed in statute. She noted some corrections that needed to be made to a few of the fire districts, and acreage amounts to a few of the special districts.

Chairman Minor opened the public hearing and asked if anyone wished to comment on proposed FY2021/2022 tax levies.

There were no comments.

There being no comment, Chairman Minor closed the public hearing.
