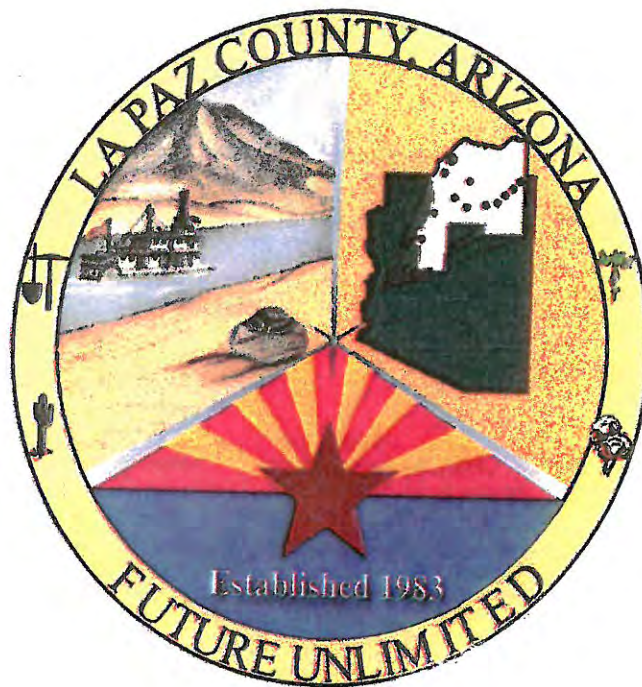

RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE JAIL DISTRICT BUDGET FISCAL YEAR 2013-2014

WHEREAS, the Jail District Board of Directors did, on the 1st day of July 2013, make an estimate of the different amounts required to meet the Jail District public expenditures/expenses for the ensuing year, also an estimate of revenues from sources other than direct taxation, and the amount to be raised by the one-half cent excise tax; and

WHEREAS, it appears that publication has been duly made of said estimates, as acquired by law.

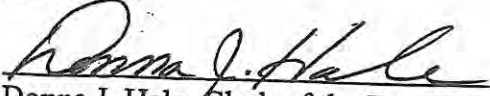
