## RESOLUTION NO. 2018-21

### A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LA PAZ APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR A NON-MOTORIZED OR MOTORIZED GRANT FOR THE HIPPIE HOLE OHV STAGING AREA/PARK INFRASTRUCTURE AND IMPROVEMENTS

**WHEREAS**, the Congress of the United States has authorized the Recreational Trails Program (RTP) as a federal-aid assistance program to help states provide and maintain recreational trails for motorized and non-motorized recreational use, and the State of Arizona has established the Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Fund to fund a variety of off-highway vehicle recreation projects, and these funds are available to eligible project sponsors for acquiring lands and developing facilities for public off-highway vehicle purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, Arizona State Parks is responsible for the administration of the Statewide OHV and RTP programs within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application by eligible project sponsors under the program; and

**WHEREAS**, said adopted procedures established by the Parks require the project sponsor to certify by resolution the approval of applications, signature authorization, the availability of local matching funds (if applicable), and authorize to sign a Project Agreement with the Parks prior to submission of said application to the Parks.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors of La Paz County:

1. Approve the filing of an application for Statewide motorized and non-motorized assistance; and
2. Certifies that the application is consistent and compatible with all adopted plans and programs of the La Paz County Board of Supervisors for motorized/non-motorized trails facilities development; and
3. Agrees to comply with all appropriate procedures, guidelines and requirements established by the Parks as part of the application process; and
4. Certifies that La Paz County will comply with all appropriate state and federal regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements as they relate to the application; and
